GENERAL SUPPORT GRANTS

General Support Grants. These grants are offered to support and enhance the work of organizations that serve the community. The supported activities should address an identified need that is responsive to one or more of the Funding Evaluation Criteria (www.ukrcfp.org/wp-content/uploads/Funding-Evaluation-Criteria.pdf). The amount of Project Support Grants is based on the recipient organization's needs as demonstrated in the financial information and budget to be submitted as a part of the grant application. Project Support Grants will generally not exceed \$5,000 and in most instances the amount awarded may be substantially less. If you have received a grant from UCFP before, please use the project General Support Grant Application (www.ukrcfp.org/wp-content/uploads/General-Support-Grant-Application.pdf) when applying for this type of grant. If this is your first time applying for this grant please use the First Time & Transformative Grant Application (www.ukrcfp.org/wp-content/uploads/First-Time-and-Transformative-Grant-Application.pdf).

General Support Grant Applications should include:

- Narrative Description. The proposal should include a narrative description of the need that the proposal seeks to address and the strategy for addressing that need.
- Budget. The proposal will include a budget with documentation of anticipated expenditures.
- Implementation Timeline. The proposal should include a timeline for program initiation and implementation.
- Advertising and Promotion. Unless clearly inapplicable, applications should include a plan to maximize community engagement with the supported program. Generally this will take the form of an advertising and promotion plan.
- Metrics. The application should also identify metrics that will be used by the applicant in grant reports to assess the success of the initiative.
